#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW APPLICANTS

We welcome you to Harbor Christian Schools. To help us process your application and reserve space in class, please complete the following the steps.

#### **Step 1.** Submit the completed forms:

- ◆ Application for Admission
- ♦ Enrollment Contract
- ◆ Permission Form/Emergency Consent Form
- ♦ Release of Liability Statement
- ◆ WA Certificate of Immunization
   (Washington State law requires this information to be on file.)

#### **Step 2.** Contact your child's previous school and arrange for the following:

- Your child's previous school records sent to us.
- ♦ Your child's present/former teacher to complete and mail us the Teacher Referral Letter

#### **Step 3.** Arrange for an admissions interview and student testing.

#### **Step 4.** Submit the necessary fees:

- ♦ Application Fee
- ◆ Registration Fee (due August 1<sup>st</sup>)
- ◆ Curriculum Fee (due August 1<sup>st</sup>)
- ♦ 1<sup>st</sup> month's tuition (due August 1<sup>st</sup>)

# Harbor Christian Schools Tuition and Fees 2021-2022

**Application Fee:** \$45.00 - New students only

This fee is non-refundable and covers the cost of testing and assessment.

**Registration Fee:** \$200.00

This fee is non-refundable and is due annually at time of registration.

#### **Curriculum Fee:**

This fee is due by August 1<sup>st</sup> annually, and is refundable through August 15<sup>th</sup>. The annual curriculum fee pays for books, resources and certain supplies.

Grades 1 - 12 \$350.00

#### **Tuition:**

Tuition is paid on a *ten-month schedule* August through May.

#### **TUITION DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE**

**Early Payment Program:** HCS rewards families who pay the annual tuition in full early.

**5% tuition reduction** if paid in full by *May 31st* 

**3% tuition reduction** if paid in full by *July 1<sup>st</sup>* 

<u>Family Plan:</u> HCS provides a discount when a family enrolls multiple students. (Full tuition is applied to the oldest student, discount applied to the next oldest.)

10% tuition reduction for the second student

**20% tuition reduction** for the *third student* 

30% tuition reduction for all others

<u>Pastor's Discount:</u> HCS provides a 50% discount on tuition to full-time pastors and ministers.

Tuition and fees cover approximately 40-50% of the schools operating costs. The remaining financial resources are raised through donations and fundraising events (i.e., annual fall fund drive, service hours, Scrip, auction, Fall Fun Run, Holiday Bazaar and Christmas Program, community breakfast, bake sales, and other class activities/fundraisers).

#### **Service Hours:**

HCS requires each family to donate **30 hours of service** (20 hours for ½ day Pre-K) to the school each year (10 of which is to be dedicated to the fundraiser/auction activities).

**Note Regarding Service Hours:** Families may choose "an OPT OUT pre-payment" at the beginning of the year at \$450.00 or \$15 per hour. Service hours are to be completed by June 10<sup>th</sup>. Families not completing their service hours are billed in May accordingly.

#### **SCRIP**:

Families are required to purchase \$1200.00 of SCRIP per year.

Scrip is the purchase of gift cards for groceries, gas, restaurants, and other amenities. You buy cards at face value and the vendors give a percentage of your purchase to our school (examples: Fred Meyer, Safeway, Albertsons, Arco, Chevron, Macys, Starbucks, etc.). Note: Families may choose "an OPT-OUT pre-payment" at the beginning of the year at \$120.00.

#### **Annual Fund Drive/Additional Fees/Transfers:**

HCS has established the 2021-22 Annual Fund Drive goal at \$30,000 and requests 100% participation.

Other additional fees may be required for field trips, labs, PE, special classes or projects.

Families transferring student(s) to HCS after the school year has begun will be prorated on Scrip, service hours, etc. based on the months/days left in the school year.
